First Families of Gilmer County, Georgia **Program Explanation**

The purpose of the First Families program is to honor the pioneers who were settled in Gilmer County by 1840 or before and to recognize those descendants who qualify as members of this program.

The proof that the applicants furnish as part of the application process will be added to the history of Gilmer County, and will become the property of the Gilmer County Genealogical Society, Inc. for research purposes.

Below are the requirements for membership:

1. Applicants must be directly descended from the early citizens listed on the 1834 or 1840 Gilmer County Census records.
2. Applicants are not required to be currently residing in Gilmer County.
3. Those who apply must have proof without doubt to ties of an ancestor listed on the 1840 Census or before.
 - a. Primary source documents must be some sort of legal documentation that verifies lineage from generation to generation. Examples: Birth, Death, Marriage Certificates; Wills; Bible records.
 - b. Secondary or supporting proof will be census records.
 - c. Tombstone photos are acceptable to verify birth and death dates. County histories and similar hearsay documents **cannot** be accepted as proof without the Primary or Secondary documents.
4. Checklist must be completed for confirmation research. (FORM 103 CL) This form will be of assistance to you, the applicant, and to the First Families Committee to verify which documents are being provided for proof of lineage between each generation. (This list will be a way of tracing yourself to your ancestor who is found on the 1834 or 1840 Gilmer County Census.)
5. Please **do not** submit original documents or original photographs as they cannot be returned. Send only copies of documents and clear copies of photos.
